POLICY ON CAGE USAGE

January 31, 2010

Priority will be given to CLL managers and coaches in good standing who wish to provide instruction and practice for registered CLL players and prospective players. Prospective players that are not registered with CLL are only eligible to participate in off-season sessions and must provide a registration form signed by their parent or guardian. For the purpose of this policy, "Off-Season" is up to the first day of Blue Mountain evaluations. After that time, the player is no longer prospective and must be registered.

CLL managers or coaches can schedule use of the facilities subject to these terms and conditions:

- Cage time must be booked with the cage coordinator. During the playing season, this is the Blue Mountain Coordinator. Off-season, this is the Coach & Player Development Coordinator.
- All players must be supervised by a CLL manager or coach in good standing.
- All users are liable for any damage to the cage and its contents.

Coquiltam Cardinals: The Cardinals are a bona fide user group that operates out of Blue Mountain Park. As such, the Cardinals have traditionally been granted use of the batting cage from time to time throughout the year,

subject to availability and the following terms and conditions (in addition to the aforementioned):

- Any such organization or individual shall indemnify and save harmless CLL, its agents and members, from any and all claims, liabilities, obligations and costs which arise out of or are in any way connected with the use of the facilities by the other organization or which arise out of or are in any way connected with a breach by the other organization of any of the terms and conditions.
- The other organization or individual shall provide liability insurance or signed Waiver Acknowledgment Form for the benefit of all, including other organization user group members, participants and CLL. Liability insurance shall be a minimum of \$2,000,000 and name Coquitlam Little League, its agents and members as Additional Insured. The Certificate of Insurance must be received by CLL prior to use of the facility by the other organization.

Alumni Usage: A past player, who participated in the CLL program for a minimum of 6 years, has reached his or her 19th birthday and is currently playing in a college or professional baseball program is eligible to apply for and be granted use of the facilities, subject to availability and the aforementioned terms and conditions.

Off-season use of the cage by an organization other than CLL (such as the Coquitlam Reds/Redlegs) can be authorized by the Coach & Player Development Coordinator and the Board of Directors. Any such use must also meet the following terms and conditions (in addition to the aforementioned):

- The organization must contribute voluntarily to CLL and its programs to be eligible to apply for cage time on a quid pro quo basis. That is, every voluntary hour contributed by the other organization can result in an hour of cage time.

If there are any extraordinary circumstances that warrant additional or not aforementioned usage, by any person or group, that specific circumstance must be brought to the Board of Directors of CLL.

Any unsatisfactory conduct, including but not limited to, misuse of cage time, facilities, or unauthorized use will result in the revocation of that person or organization's use of CLL facilities.

All policies on the use of CLL facilities are subject to change at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
