Team Composition:

The Junior old All Star team will be made based on; regular season stats, team makeup, and tryouts that include assessing speed, fielding, throwing, hitting and baseball IQ.

Calendar:

The first practice of the 2019 Junior All Star team will be on Wednesday, June 19th at 6pm. From 7:30-8:00-pm, each player and one guardian will meet with the Manager to discuss team roles. Tournament Dates:

Provincial Championship - July 13- 16, 2019 in Central Saanich, BC

National Championship - July 28 - August 4, 2019 in Lethbridge, AB

World Series - August 11-18, 2019 in Taylor, Michigan

Parent Duties:

Parent duties help your child have an even better on field experience! All parents are expected to help with home games as we prepare for the Provincial Championship.

Uniform:

All players will be given a new hat, belt, socks, pants, League jersey and keeper jersey with their name and number on it. Players are required to wear white baseball pants.

Baseball pants are expected for all games and practices unless told otherwise. Players should always bring a pair of runners in case we hit in the cage. Be weather aware and bring a jacket or hoodie if it is cold. Sleeves should always be worn unless the temperature is above 20C

Cost:

The Cost for Junior Allstars is \$100. This includes uniform, equipment and umpires fees for exhibition games. This can be paid by cash or cheque (made payable to CLL). Note that Provincial costs (accommodation, food, etc) are the responsibility of each player. If we are successful and go to the Canadian Championship, each player's fee will be approximately \$600. If we go to the World Series, players will only have to pay for optional snacks and merchandise.

General:

- A full commitment is expected. Players who are unable to attend an event (practice, game, etc), must notify the manager in advance. If a player is unable to regularly attend events, their spot on the team will be reconsidered.
- Players who are not selected to the Junior All Star team are eligible to play on the Senior All Star team.
- Players should always have a refillable water bottle with them.
- Candy and sunflower seeds are not allowed but players are welcome to bring healthy snacks to games and practices.

Paperwork:

All players need to submit the following paperwork in order to participate:

- Medical Release Form
- Travel Authorization Form - 'Little League' division form only
- Residency Documents OR School Enrollment Form (see residency form for complete details)
- Photocopy of passport
- Photocopy of birth certificate
- Media Release Form

Paperwork must be submitted as soon as possible to the Manager.
